In this letter we would like to give you a brief overview of the Directive 2003/11/EG and its implementation in our company.

The Guidelines

The Guidelines 2003/11/EG of the EU (restriction on the marketing and use of certain dangerous substances) forbids the use, or more exactly the marketing of both of the halogenated flame retardants Penta and Octa bromated Diphenylether.

These guideline is valid for all applications of these substances within the EU and have already been included into national legislation

The guidelines which come into force as of the 1st July 2006, EU – Guidelines 2002/95/EG (RoHS – specifically for the electronics industry) exceed and include the requirements of 2003/11/EG (general).
